If guidelines are to be effective, they need to have most, if not all, of the following 11 characteristics 8: validity, cost effectiveness, reproducibility, reliability, representative development, clinical applicability, clinical flexibility, clarity, meticulous documentation, scheduled review, and unscheduled review.

The most important element in nursing best practices is communication — especially during a shift change. During a shift change, nurses record and transfer important patient information, and it is imperative that the information is accurate and complete. There is a greater risk of patient care mistakes during a nurse-to-nurse shift change.
