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The graphs show the probability that a subject will survive beyond time t . For example, for survival function 1, the probability of surviving longer than $t = 2$ months is 0.37. That is, 37% of subjects survive more than 2 months. For survival function 2, the probability of surviving longer than $t = 2$ months is 0.97.

Estimators. The efficiency of an unbiased estimator, T , of a parameter θ is defined as $e(T) = \frac{V(T)}{V(T_{opt})}$ where $V(T)$ is the Fisher information of the sample. Thus $e(T)$ is the minimum possible variance for an unbiased estimator divided by its actual variance. The Cramér-Rao bound can be used to prove that $e(T) \leq 1$. Efficient estimators.
